

Highway 15 Project Update & Construction Sequencing

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MnDOT District 8 - Willmar

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Summary of work

- Reconstruction of Hwy 15 through downtown/Main Street (7 blocks). A detour is necessary.
- City of Hutchinson is replacing aging utilities between 2nd Ave. N and 5th Ave. S
- Resurfacing Hwy 15 from 5th Ave. S to just north of the roundabout at CR 115/Airport Road (1.7 miles). No detour.
- Replace sidewalks and update pedestrian crossings along both project areas to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards
- Addition of (north bound) left turn lane at Linden Ave. NEW

Goals & benefits

- Pavement has deteriorated and needs to be replaced
- Modernize water main and sanitary and storm sewers
- Help to ensure the state and city infrastructure serves their purpose for many years
- Pavement preservation and a smoother ride
- Ensure sidewalks and crossings are accessible for people with disabilities

Downtown amenities

- Both new and existing features (amenities) are included in the final design
- Bump-outs will • be used at key locations only, not every intersection

Project cost & timeline

- Both parts of the project, reconstruction and resurfacing, are estimated to cost \$8 million dollars (state and city)
- Reconstruction is set to begin in spring of 2020 and will take the entire season
- The resurfacing part of the project will take 2-3 weeks for the roadway and 2-3 weeks for the sidewalk replacement, but will be completed under traffic.

Detour


PROJECT AREA & OFFICIAL DETOUR




- Details related to the sequencing for the reconstruction of Main Street through downtown are subject to change and dependent on the weather
- The following is meant to provide general information
- There are times when there will be traffic delays
- There are times where there will be limited or temporary access to businesses

- Construction will start at the north end of Main Street (2nd Ave. N) and move south
- Local traffic only means that local traffic can access downtown businesses in the project area/designated work zone. All other traffic must use the official detour.
- The road is not open. It is accessible for people to get to businesses and residences
- Barricades indicate a closed road or sidewalk and must not be crossed

- Underground utilities, road and curb and gutter will be reconstructed first
- Sidewalks in front of the building will be kept in place as long as possible, but will require intermittent closures and some temporary access.
- Businesses should encourage customers to use rear access as much as possible.



- The majority of work done within each construction area will be done within that specific area outlined on the map, but the full project area will be a work zone where work can be performed at any time.
- Work will overlap between the areas outlined in the sequencing.









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


Area Under Construction

- Barricades cannot be crossed.


